# Ending structure to know: Infinitives

■ Present:	εἶν	εσθαῖ	
Second Aorist:	εἶν	εσθαῖ	ἦναι
First Aorist:	αῖ	ασθαῖ	ἦναι
Perfect:	ναι	σθαῖ	

# Subjunctive Review

## Present(Continuous) Active

- PAS λύω λύης λύη,  
λύωμεν, λύητε, λύωσι(ν)
- PM/PS λύωμαι, η, ηται,  
ώμεθα, ησθε, ωνται
- AAS λύσω λύσης λύση,  
λύσωμεν, λύσητε, λύσωσι(ν)
- AMS λύσωμαι, η, ηται,  
ώμεθα, ησθε, ωνται
- APS λύθω λύθης λύθη, λύθωμεν, λύθητε,  
λύθωσι(ν)

# Imperative ending soft shoe

## ■ Present Imperative

◆ -ε, -τω, -τε, -τωσαν (Active)

-ου, -σθω, -σθε, -σθωσαν (M/Pas)

## ■ First Aorist Imperative

◆ -υ, -τω, -τε, -τωσαν (Active)

-αι, -σθω, -σθε, -σθωσαν (Mid)

-τι, -τω, -τε, -τωσαν (Pas)

## ■ Second Aorist endings = present endings + -τι in the passive

# Paradigm δίδωμι -- give it to -μι

- Spanish endings:

δίδωμι .... -μι, -ς, -σι, -μεν, -τε, -ασι

- Present      Imperfect      Future      Aorist

■ 1	δίδωμι	ἐδίδουν	δώσω	ἔδωκα
2	δίδως	ἐδίδους	δώσεις	ἔδωκας
3	δίδωσι	ἐδίδου	δώσει	ἔδωκε(ν)
1	δίδομεν	εδίδομεν	δώσομεν	ἔδώκαμεν
2	δίδοτε	ἐδίδοτε	δώσετε	ἔδώκατε
3	διδόασι	εδίδοσαν	δώσουσι	ἔδωκαν

- Perfect add a δ on the front of the Aorist

# 6 Types of Pronouns

- **Personal Pronouns:** ἐγώ, σύ, αὐτός
- **Demonstrative:** οὗτος, ἐκεῖνος
- **Reciprocal pronoun:** ἀλλήλων (one another)
- **Relative Pronouns:** ὅς, ἣ, ὅ who, which
- **Reflexive:** myself, yourself (ἐμαυτοῦ, σεαυτοῦ, ἑαυτοῦ)
- **Indefinite Pronoun:** τις / τι (someone)

# Reflexive Pronouns-- of myself

■ ἐμαυτοῦ -ῆς of myself (Masc)

■                    Singular                    Plural

■ Gen. ἐμαυτοῦ                    ἐαυτῶν

Dat. ἐμαυτῶ                    ἐαυτοῖς

Acc. ἐμαυτόν                    ἐαυτούς

# Reflexive Pronouns- of myself

■ ἐμαυτοῦ -ῆς of myself (Fem)

	Singular	Plural
■ Gen.	ἐμαυτῆς	ἐαυτῶν
Dat.	ἐμαυτῇ	ἐαυταῖς
Acc.	ἐμαυτήν	ἐαυτάς

# Reflexive Pronoun -- of yourself

- σεαυτοῦ -ῆς of yourself (Masc)

	Singular	Plural
■ Gen.	σεαυτοῦ/ῆς	ἑαυτῶν
Dat.	σεαυτῶ/ῆ	ἑαυτοῖς/αῖς
Acc.	σεαυτόν/ήν	ἑαυτούς/άς

# Reflexive Pronoun -- of him/her/itself

- ἑαυτοῦ -ῆς of him/her/itself

	Singular	Plural
■ Gen.	ἑαυτοῦ	ἑαυτῶν
■ Dat.	ἑαυτῷ	ἑαυτοῖς
■ Acc.	ἑαυτόν	ἑαυτούς

# Possessive Adjectives

- ἐμός -- my  
σός -- your
- ἡμέτερος -- our  
ὕμέτερος -- your
- These are sometimes used instead of the Genitive case of the personal pronouns

# Indefinite Pronouns

■ **τις / τι** someone, anything (enclitic)

■ **Singular (note 3rd decl.)**

■ **M/F                      Neut**

■ **Nom.**                      **τις                      τι**

**Gen.**                      **τινός                      τινός**

**Dat.**                      **τινί                      τινί**

**Acc.**                      **τινά                      τι**

■ **Note:** Accent on the last syllable,  
with no accent when single syllable

# Indefinite Pronouns

- Plural (note 3rd decl.)

■	M/F	Neut
■ Nom.	τινές	τινά
Gen.	τινῶν	τινῶν
Dat.	τισί(ν)	τισί(ν)
Acc.	τινάς	τινά

- Note: Accent on the last syllable,  
with no accent when single syllable

# 6 ways to ask a question

## ■ Interrogatives

- πότε when?
- ποῦ where?
- πῶς how?
- τίς, τί who? which? what?
- διὰ τί why?
- τί why?

# Interrogative Pronoun

- τίς / τί who? which? what? (n.b. accent)

Singular (note 3rd decl.)

	M/F	Neut
■ Nom.	τίς	τί
■ Gen.	τίνος	τίνος
■ Dat.	τίνι	τίνι
■ Acc.	τίνα	τί

- Note: Accent on first syllable, accented when single syllable



# Greek Numbers

## ■ Two types:

◆ Cardinal numbers: 1, 2, 3, 4....

◆ Ordinal numbers: first, second, third

## ■ Greek Ordinals (tell order)

◆ πρῶτος, -η, -ον      first

◆ δεύτερος, -α, -ον      second

◆ τρίτος, -η, -ον      third

◆ τέταρτος, -η, -ον      fourth


